FREE WATER WELL MONITORING

Our “neighbors helping neighbors” monthly water monitoring program is free. We use Sierra Club meters to test for the same “indicators” of water quality the Club measures in their *Water Sentinel Program*. While this is not a substitute for a Tier III water test by an EPA certified lab, it can provide peace of mind for those who live near current or future oil or gas wells (or injection wells).

Water monitoring is most effective when results are collected each month. With a consistent record, we can detect significant changes in

your drinking water that could be indicators of contamination. *Call or email for latest information about monitoring especially around holidays.*

We’ll keep track of your results (and give you a copy, too) so we can watch for spikes in numbers, indicating possible disturbances in your well water quality. Encourage your neighbors to join our water monitoring program, as wider testing will increase our ability to track and identify possible disturbances in area water quality.in neighborhoods around Portage County.

Taking your water sample. For accurate readings, your sample should be taken as directly from the well as possible--- **before any treatment and within an hour before we test it.** For a sample “fresh from the well,” drain the water sitting in your pipes by running any household cold water for about 10 minutes **before** you collect your sample (from the well head or from a faucet on your pump). Use a clean, wide-mouthed, covered glass container that holds about 8 oz..
